ACTION ALERT!

Coming Soon – to your neighbourhood – Monsterplexes

On May 10, City Council will be discussing allowing triplexes and fourplexes on every residential street in Toronto. Toronto has a housing crisis and needs more residences that someone earning minimum wage can afford. Multiplexes need to provide genuine affordable rental units.

The Multiplex Bylaw, as currently proposed is flawed.

- It eliminates floor space index (FSI) for multiplexes. FSI is a planning tool that controls the size of a building on a lot. It is a restriction on developers that protects immediate neighbours and the community;
- Multiplexes are allowed to be 19m long (~62 feet). Presently houses have a limit of 17 m (~55 feet);

If this By-Law is passed, these changes would be permitted as-of-right.

This means a property owner can build a multiplex without letting immediate neighbours know about it. Neighbours will not have the right to object.

- The Multiplex Bylaw places no limits on the number of multiplexes on a street and puts the onus on proponents to identify existing trees and the need to remove them. The destruction of mature trees in our neighbourhoods will accelerate;
- We are concerned that there will be a greater risk of flooding with larger buildings producing
 more surface water runoff, more paved surfaces for parking, a greater loss of our valuable tree
 canopy and the fabric of communities will be altered;
- No communities or neighbourhoods will be immune from this new By-law

This is a complicated by-law which is being pushed through at lightning speed without meaningful information to and engagement with Toronto residents. What can you do?

Write to your Councillor, either Councillor Crawford, <u>councillor_crawford@toronto.ca</u> or Councillor Ainslie, <u>councillor_ainslie@toronto.ca</u>. Ask them to defer the Multiplex proposal until **after** the next Mayor of Toronto is elected and make improvements to the bylaw to retain planning controls.
