Thank you for taking the time to meet with us in response to our inquiry pertaining to Item 2025.MM29.18 regarding Scarborough Bluffs West Project: Environmental Assessment Agreement motion. <https://cliffcrestscarboroughvillagesw.ca/data/documents/TRCA-motion.pdf>

Following our June 18, 2025 meeting we understood that changes to legislation in the Environmental Assessment Act required the Voluntary Agreement to ensure the project fit into the category of a Comprehensive Assessment. As you noted, the intent of the motion was to correct an administrative item that had been overlooked, there really was no need to rush, and that there was no consequence with regards to the delay to the motion to the project. We were glad to hear the Comprehensive Assessment remains on track and all is well.

We understand that the proposed Terms of Reference have been placed on public record for a 30-day period starting June 20, 2025 and ending July 20, 2025 for review and comment.
